directors will discuss and, depending on the nature of the conflict, vote on either (a) whether or not to continue the transaction at issue or (b) measures to address the situation at issue. Directors subject to a conflict shall not be permitted to be present or to participate in the deliberations or vote of the qualified directors with respect to such conflict. Recusal of the director shall require such director to physically remove himself or herself from the communication. Resolution of the matter may include (a) approving or disapproving any transaction or situation at issue; (b) requiring the director to remove himself or herself from positions in which the conflict of interest exists until there is no longer a conflict; or (c) requiring the director to discontinue, reduce, or modify his or her participation in the board, committees, or task forces where the conflict exists. In addition to these procedures, directors have an obligation to address any perceived conflict of interest of other directors if they are aware of such conflicts with respect to matters pertaining to IPTX.
